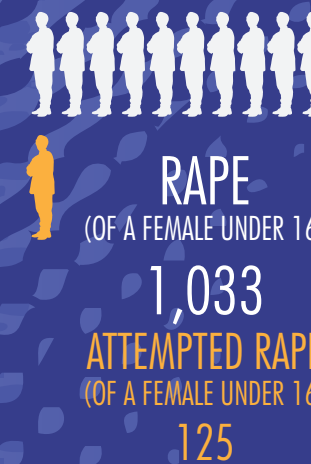
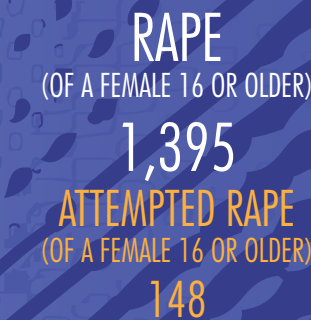
RAPES REPORTED TO POLICE

What chance do they have of seeing justice done?



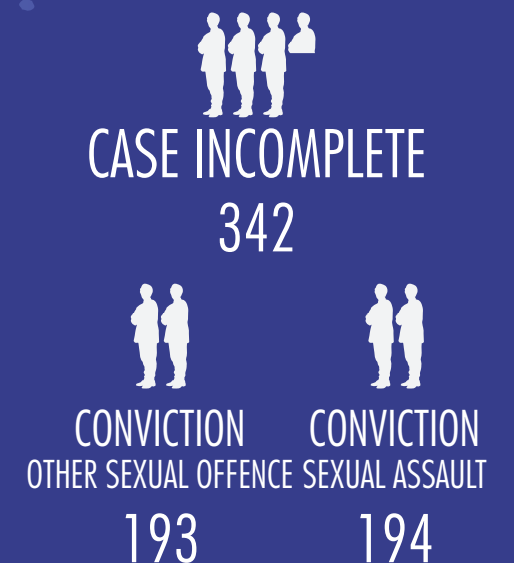
SUSPECTS CHARGED

* ON AVERAGE, BETWEEN 2009 & 2011, 415 DEFENDANTS ENTERED A GUILTY PLEA AND OVER HALF OF ALL CONVICTIONS WERE FOR OFFENCES AGAINST UNDER 16s.
DURING THIS SAME PERIOD THERE WERE, ON AVERAGE, 102 CONVICTIONS A YEAR FOR ATTEMPTED RAPE.
